

Inquiry into the convictions of Kathleen Megan Folbigg

Direction as to procedure

- 1. Counsel Assisting the Inquiry will call each witness who is to give evidence before the Inquiry.
- 2. The normal procedure will be that a witness statement is prepared, tendered and adopted by the witness who will then be cross-examined.
- 3. If a party wishes to place evidence before the Inquiry, that evidence should be provided to the solicitor assisting the Inquiry within a time to be specified before the public hearing.
- 4. Counsel Assisting will determine if that evidence is to be tendered and if the tender is refused, an application can be made to the Judicial Officer.
- 5. Counsel Assisting will determine the order in which the witnesses are to be called.
