



Inquiry into the convictions of Kathleen Megan Folbigg

Direction as to procedure

1. Counsel Assisting the Inquiry will call each witness who is to give evidence before the Inquiry.
2. The normal procedure will be that a witness statement is prepared, tendered and adopted by the witness who will then be cross-examined.
3. If a party wishes to place evidence before the Inquiry, that evidence should be provided to the solicitor assisting the Inquiry within a time to be specified before the public hearing.
4. Counsel Assisting will determine if that evidence is to be tendered and if the tender is refused, an application can be made to the Judicial Officer.
5. Counsel Assisting will determine the order in which the witnesses are to be called.
